

UNDERSTANDING CATASTROPHIC INJURIES

By definition, a catastrophic injury is any wound or ailment that causes severe debilitation or pain, or leaves permanent negative impacts upon the victim. When people act negligently and do not regard the safety and wellbeing of others, a normal situation that should have unfolded without complication or worry can become extremely dangerous. It is often in these unexpected moments, such as [car accidents](#) or construction site accidents, that catastrophic injuries occur.

To this extent, everyone must be careful not to hurt others in routine situations, and those who cause harm must be held liable for their actions.

Examples of catastrophic injuries include:

- [Spinal cord injuries](#)
- Traumatic brain injuries
- Scarring and disfigurement
- Paralysis
- Amputation

As mentioned above, a catastrophic injury is an injury that is going to last a lifetime. If the liable party does offer you a settlement upfront for what they have done, it is important that you do not initially accept it without first consulting with your personal injury attorney. The likelihood of such an offer actually providing all the compensation you will require is extremely low, and once you accept it, litigation may become more difficult for you.

Compensation for a catastrophic injury should help pay for:

- Emergency medical care
- Therapy and rehabilitation for the rest of your life
- Reduced wages and lost career opportunities
- Emotional trauma and lessened standard of living

In terms of medical care and costs being compensated, you will want to undergo ample evaluations from professionals in relevant medical fields. Only after these have been completed and reviewed by your attorney will you have a suitable estimation of just how much compensation you need when considering all the remaining years of your life. This is called maximized compensation, and you should not settle for anything less.
